

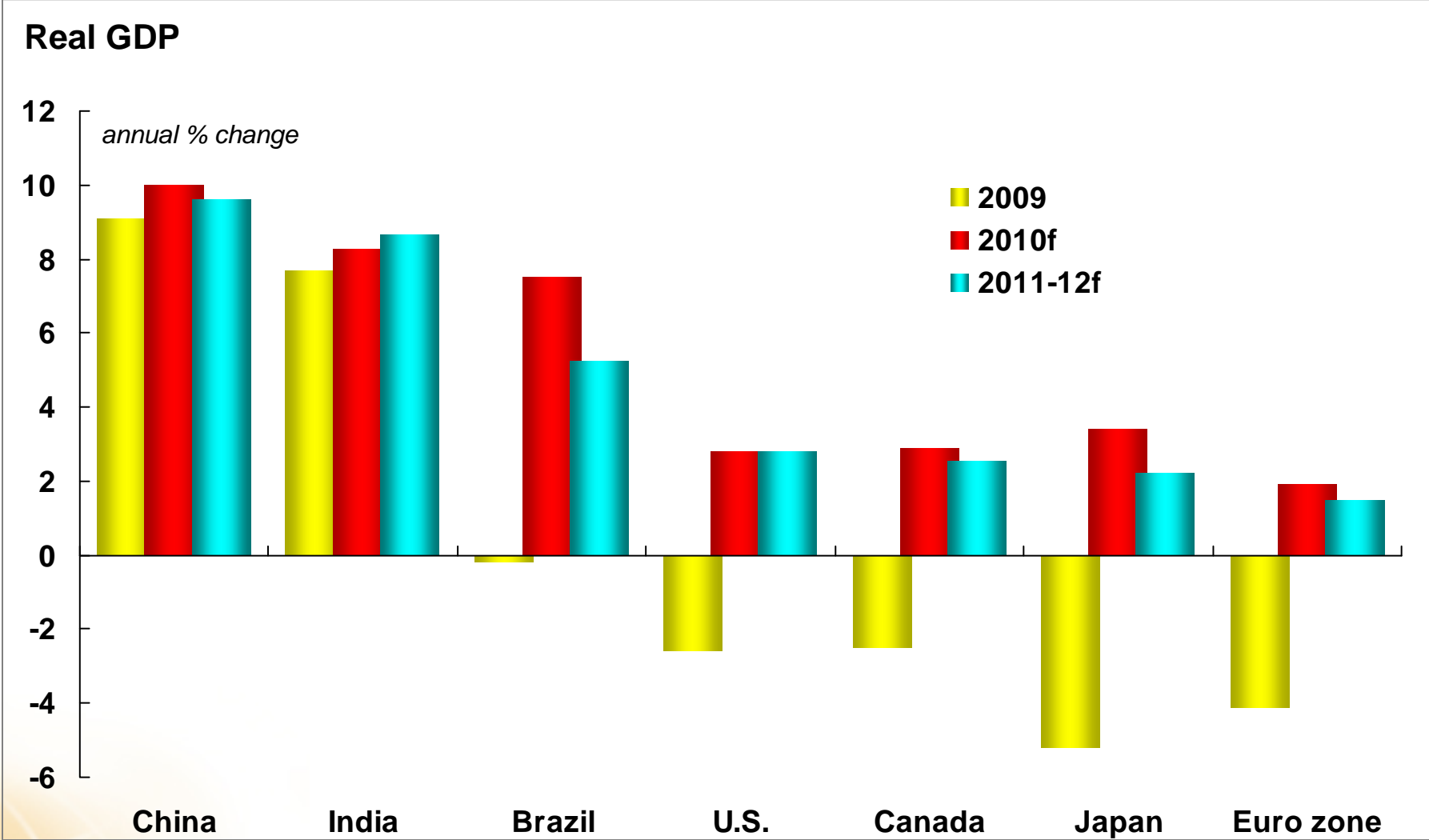

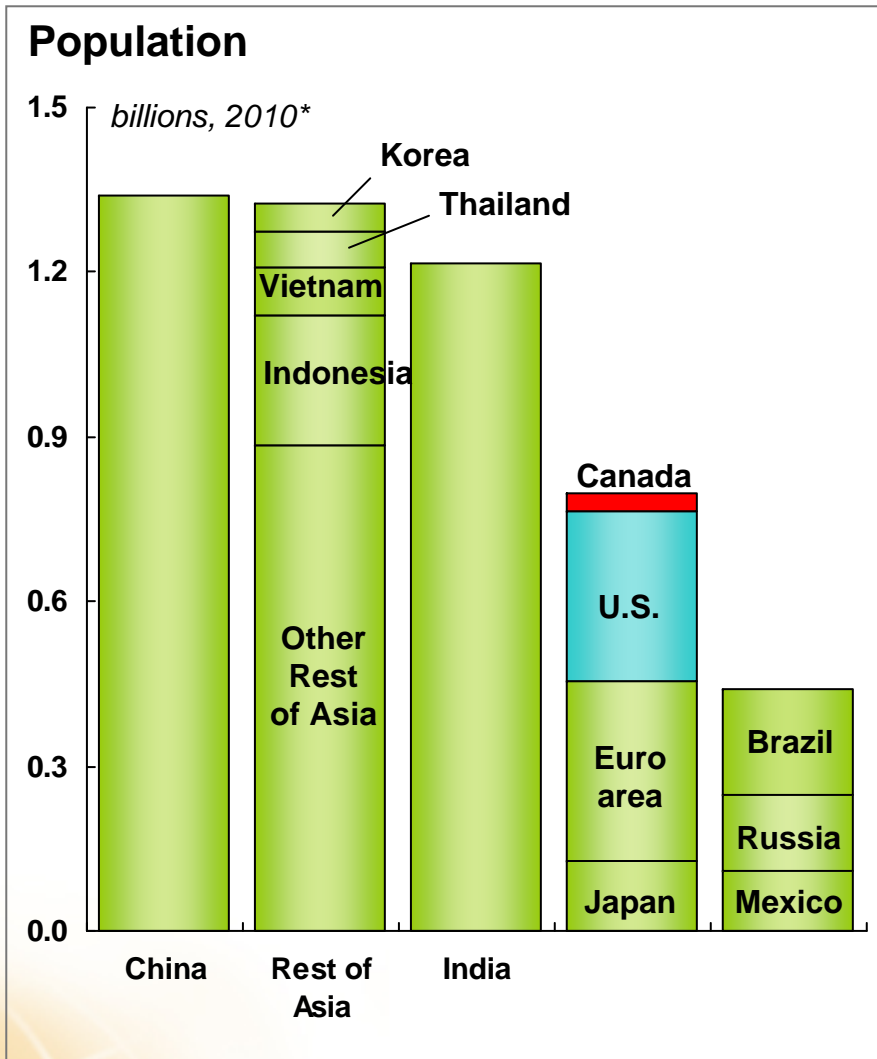

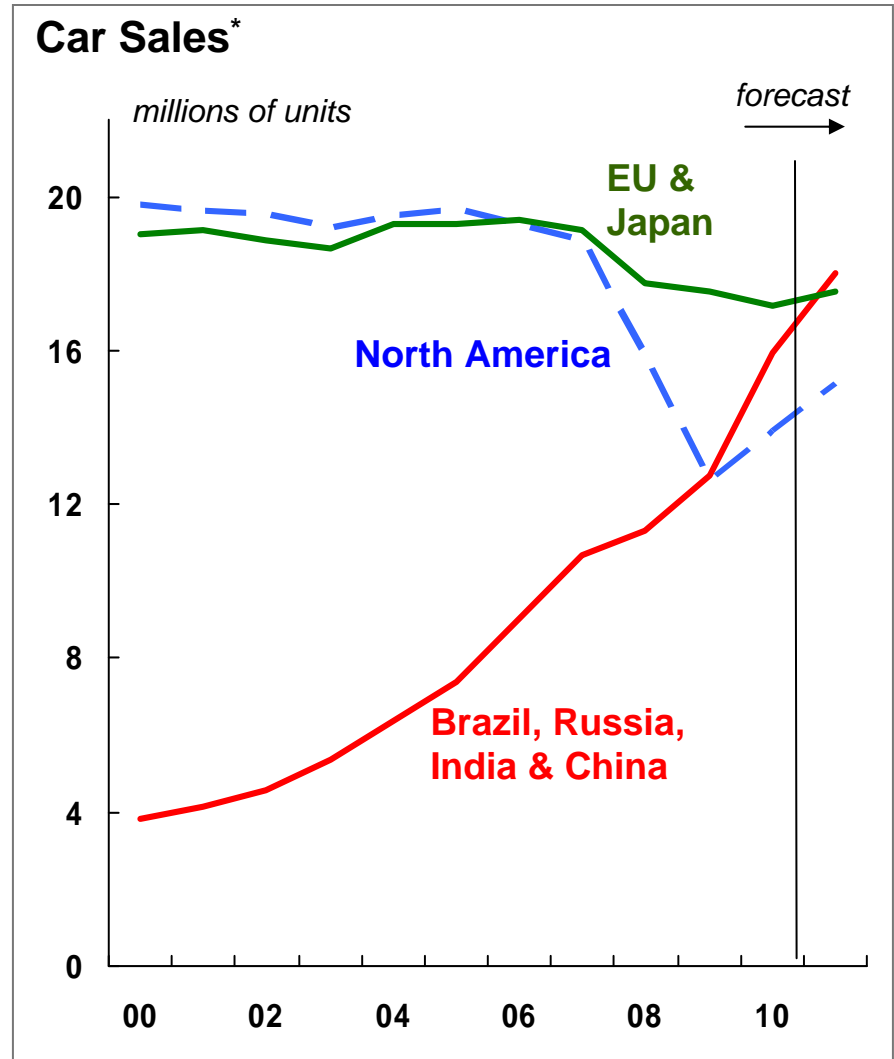

# ... Driven by Robust Emerging Market Demand



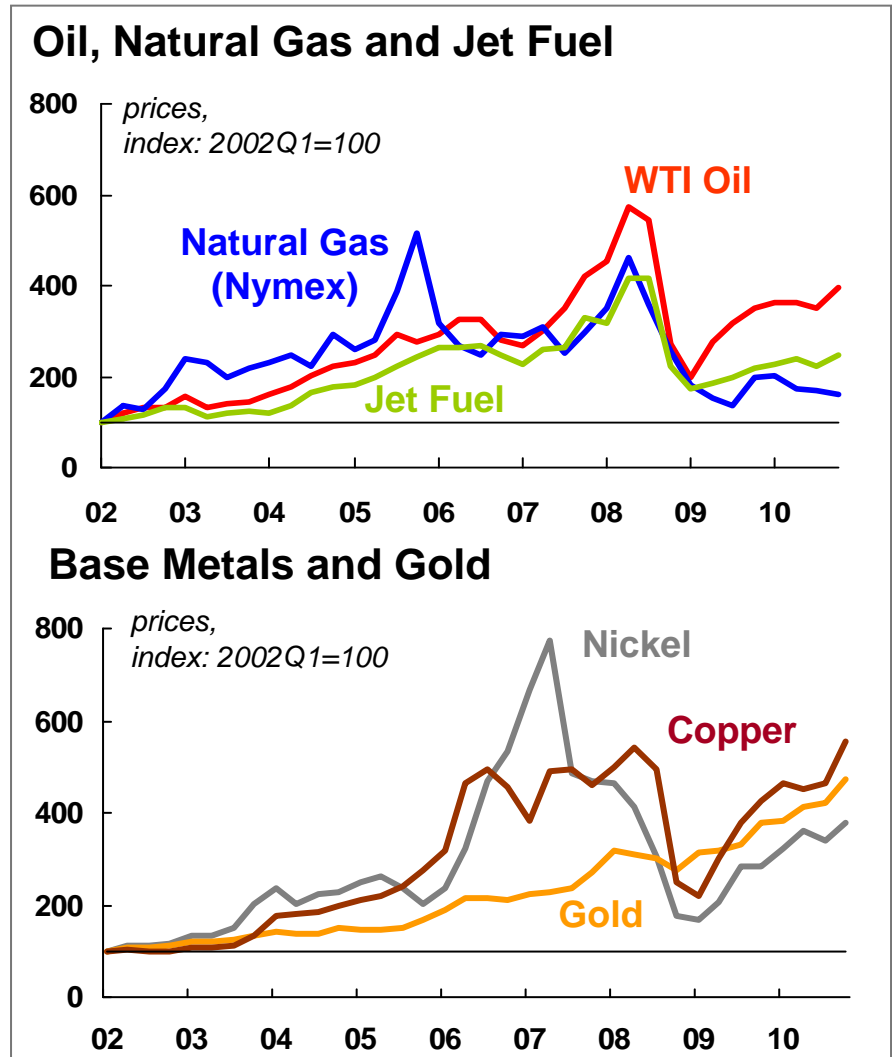
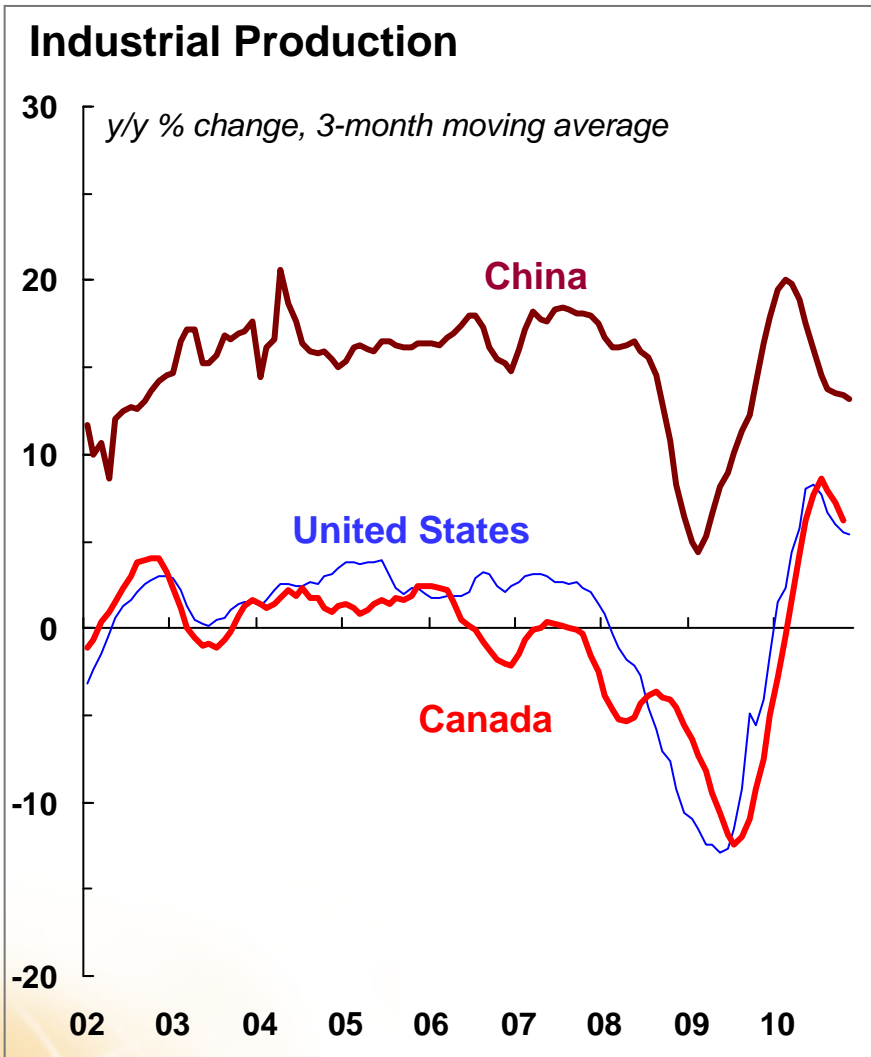

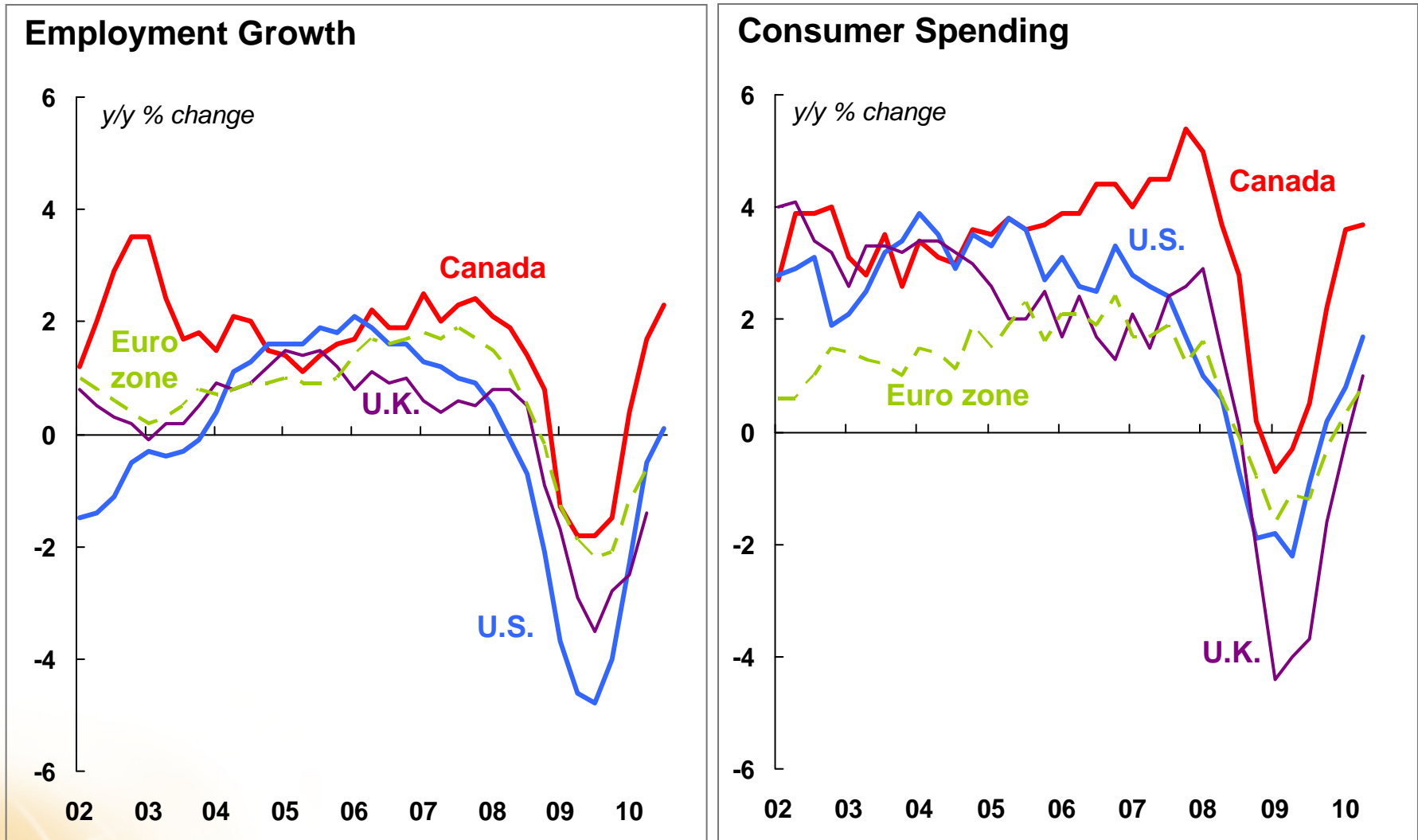


# Production Gains have Boosted Commodity Prices ...



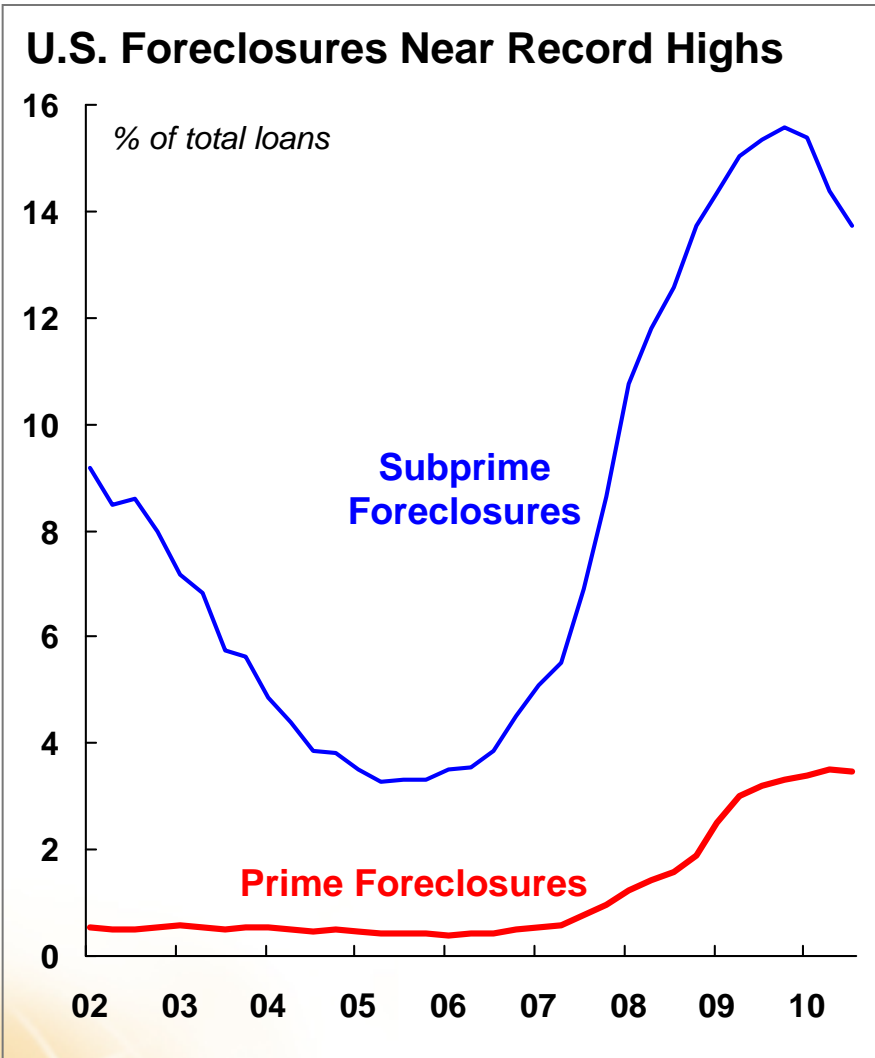

## ... but the Recovery in Developed Nations is Uneven ...

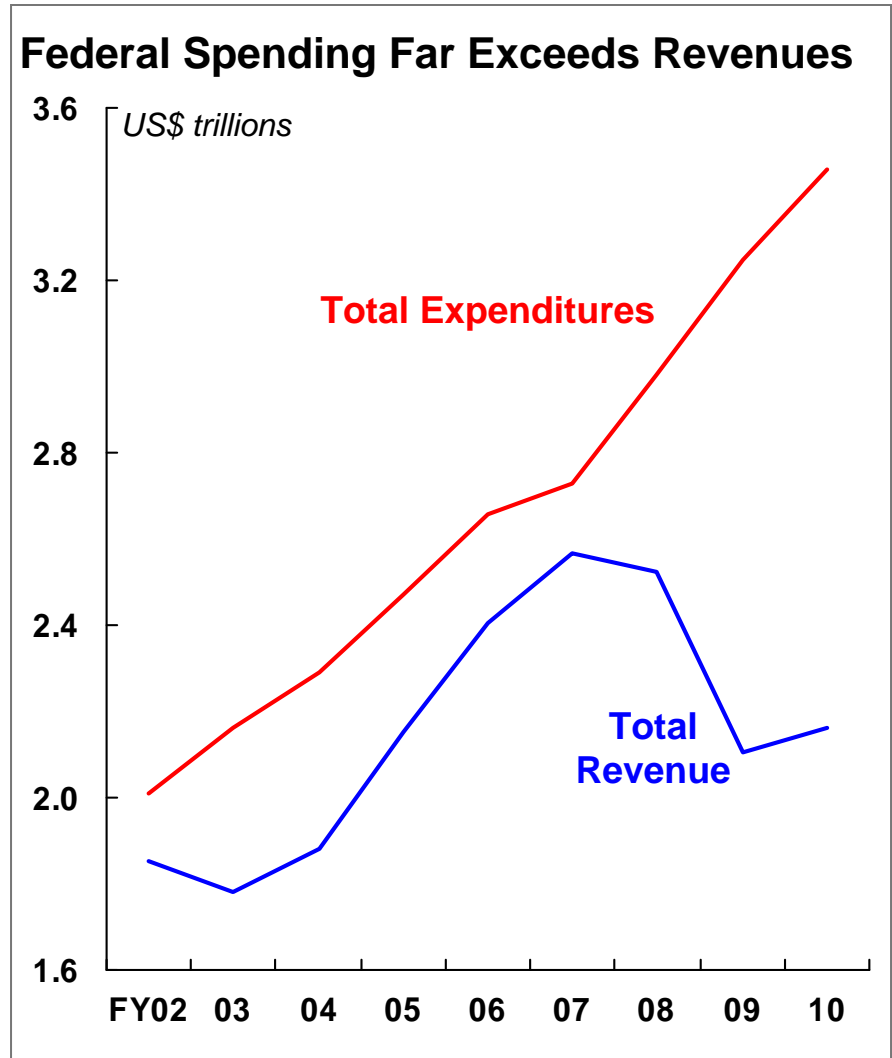

# ... U.S. Financial Strains Remain Intense ...



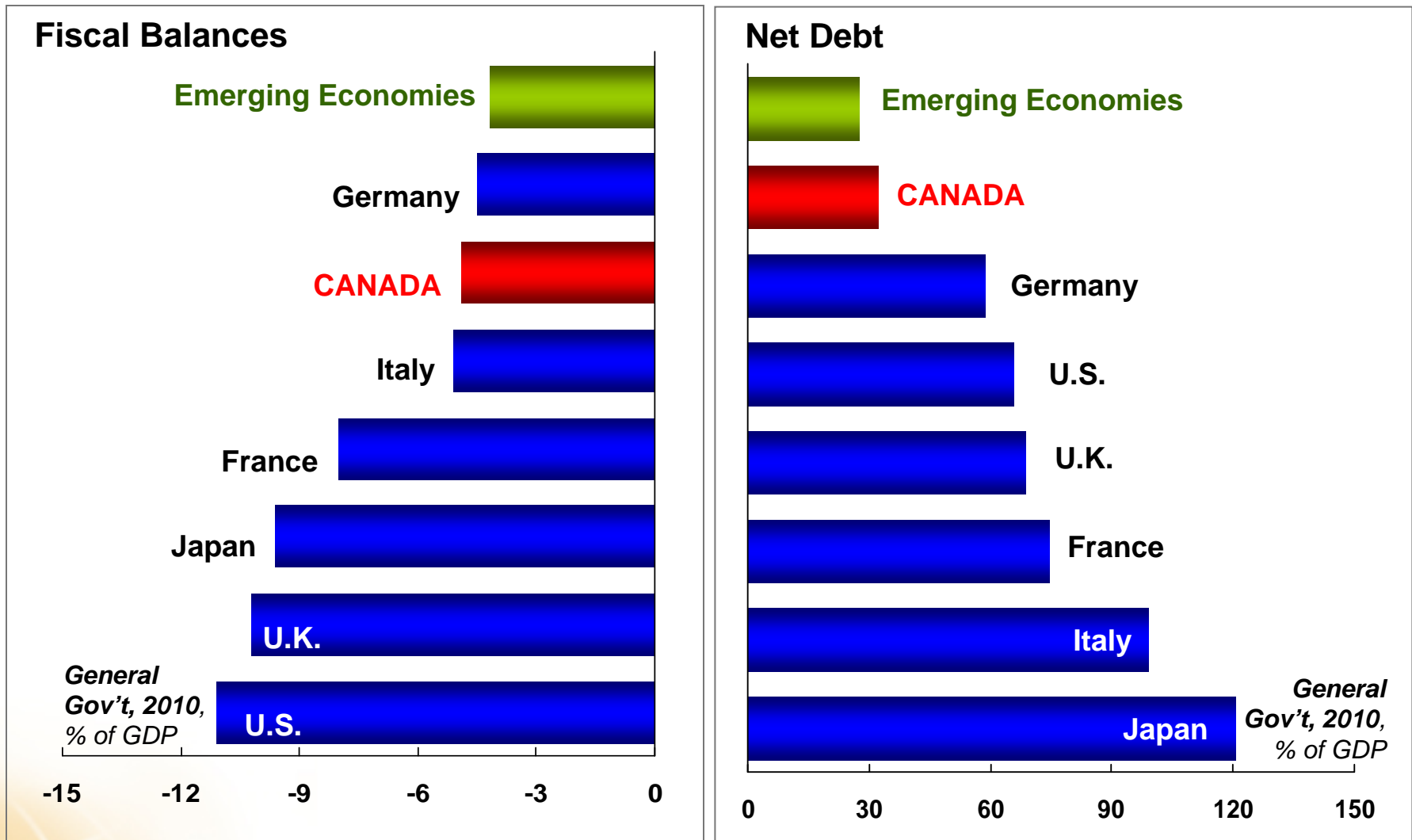

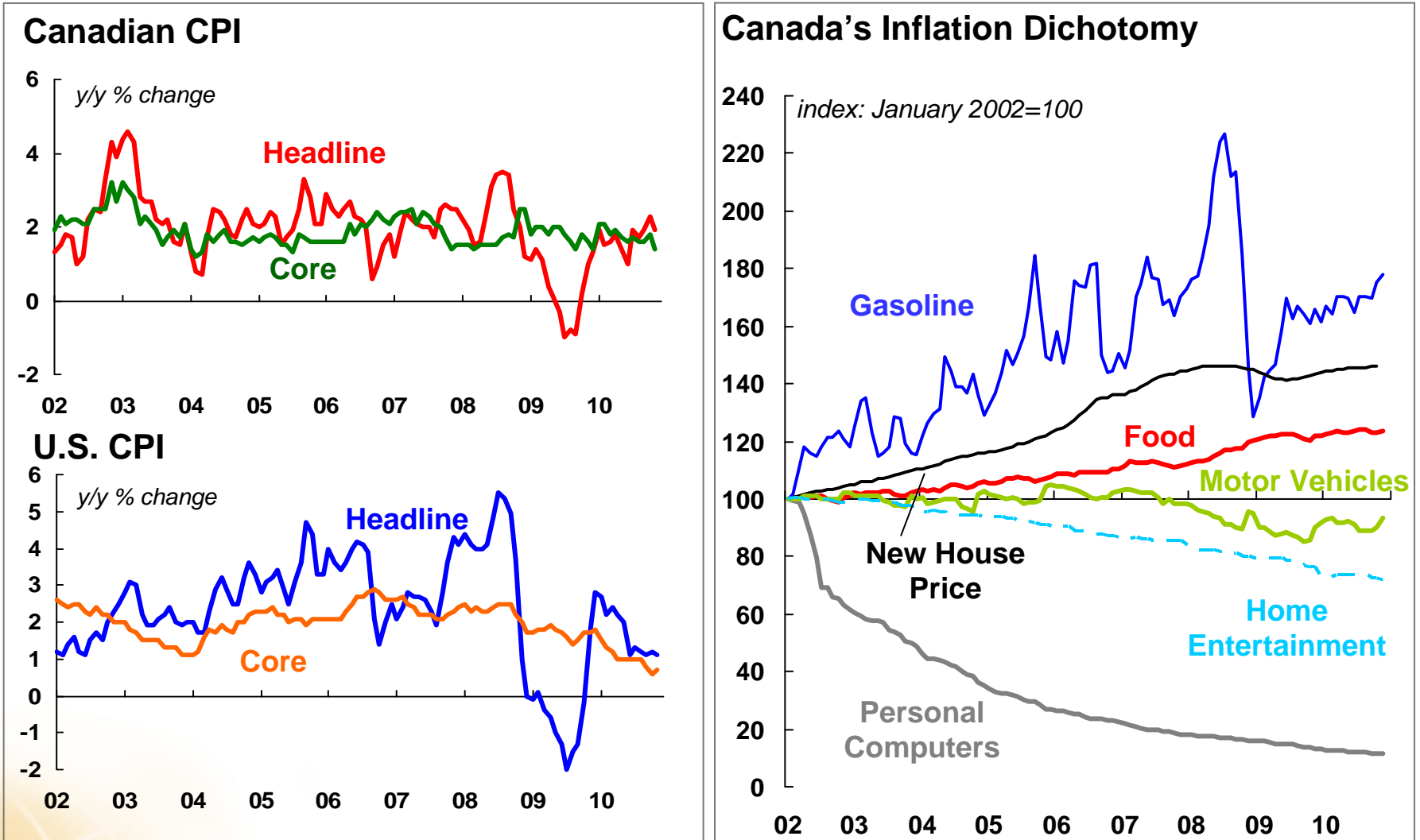


# ... & Fiscal Repair will Temper Growth Beyond Mid-Decade

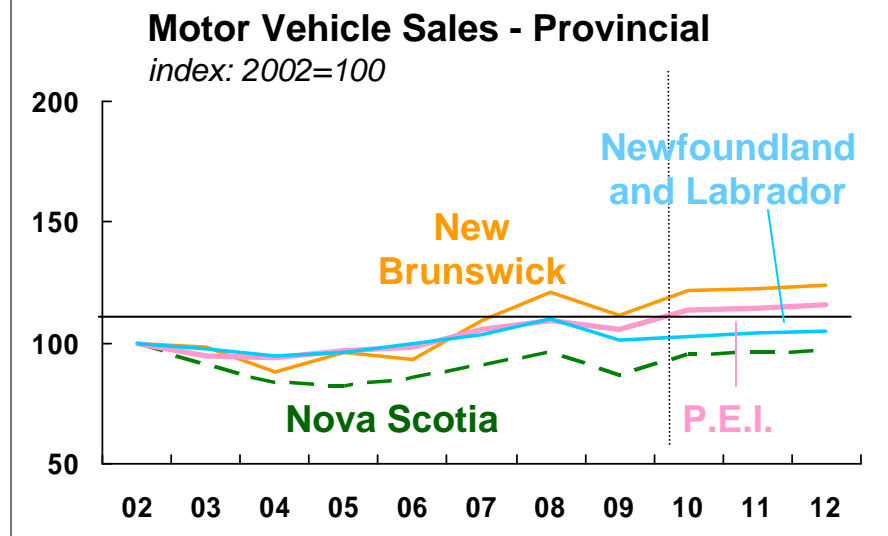
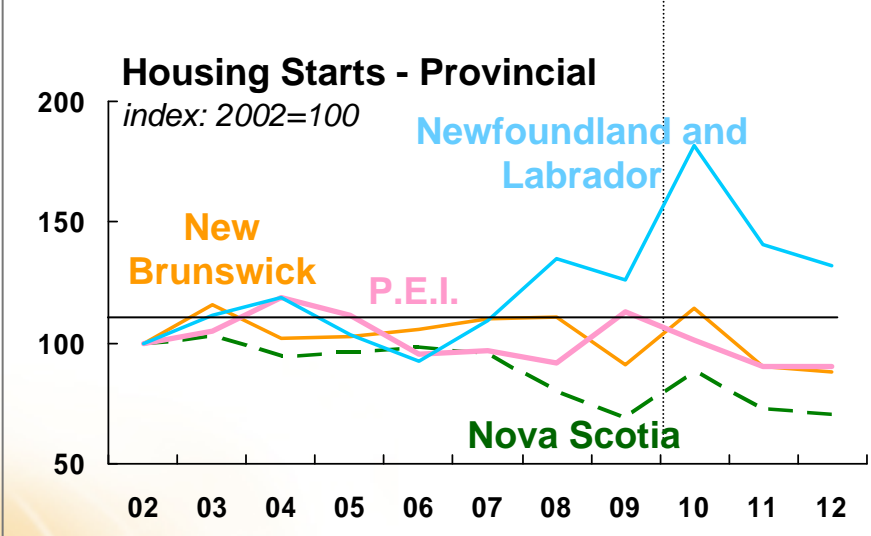
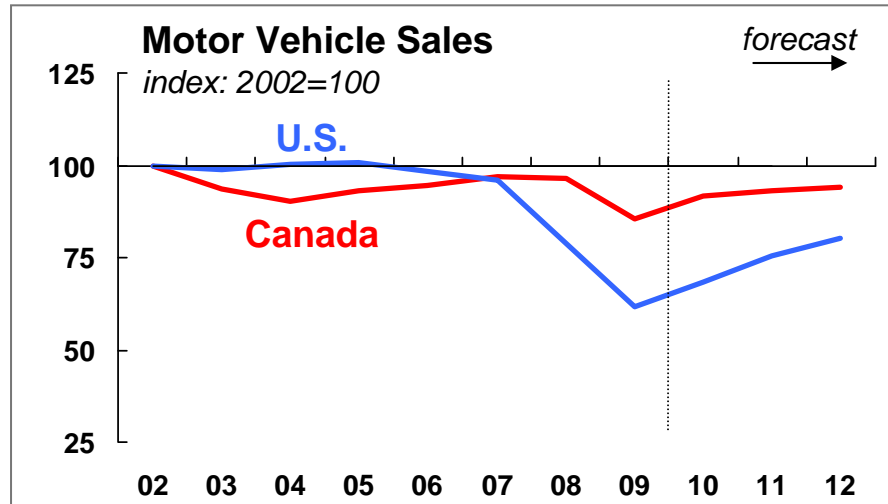
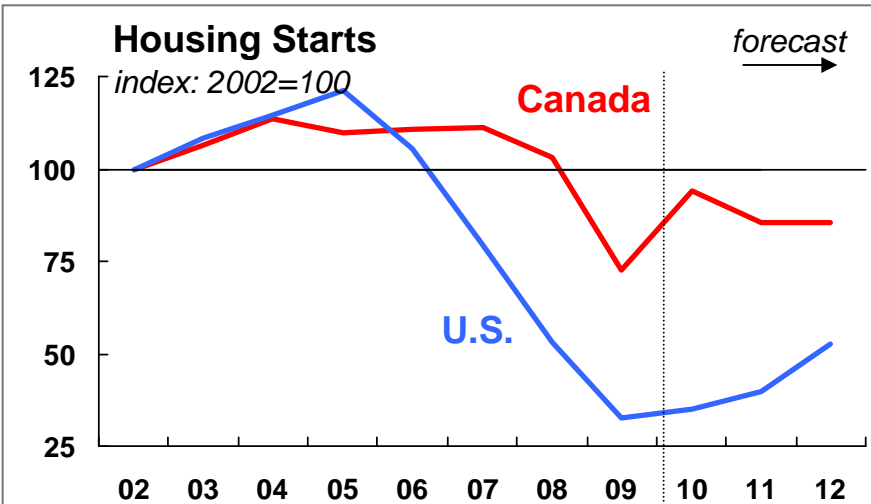
# Inflation Risks are Low – For Now

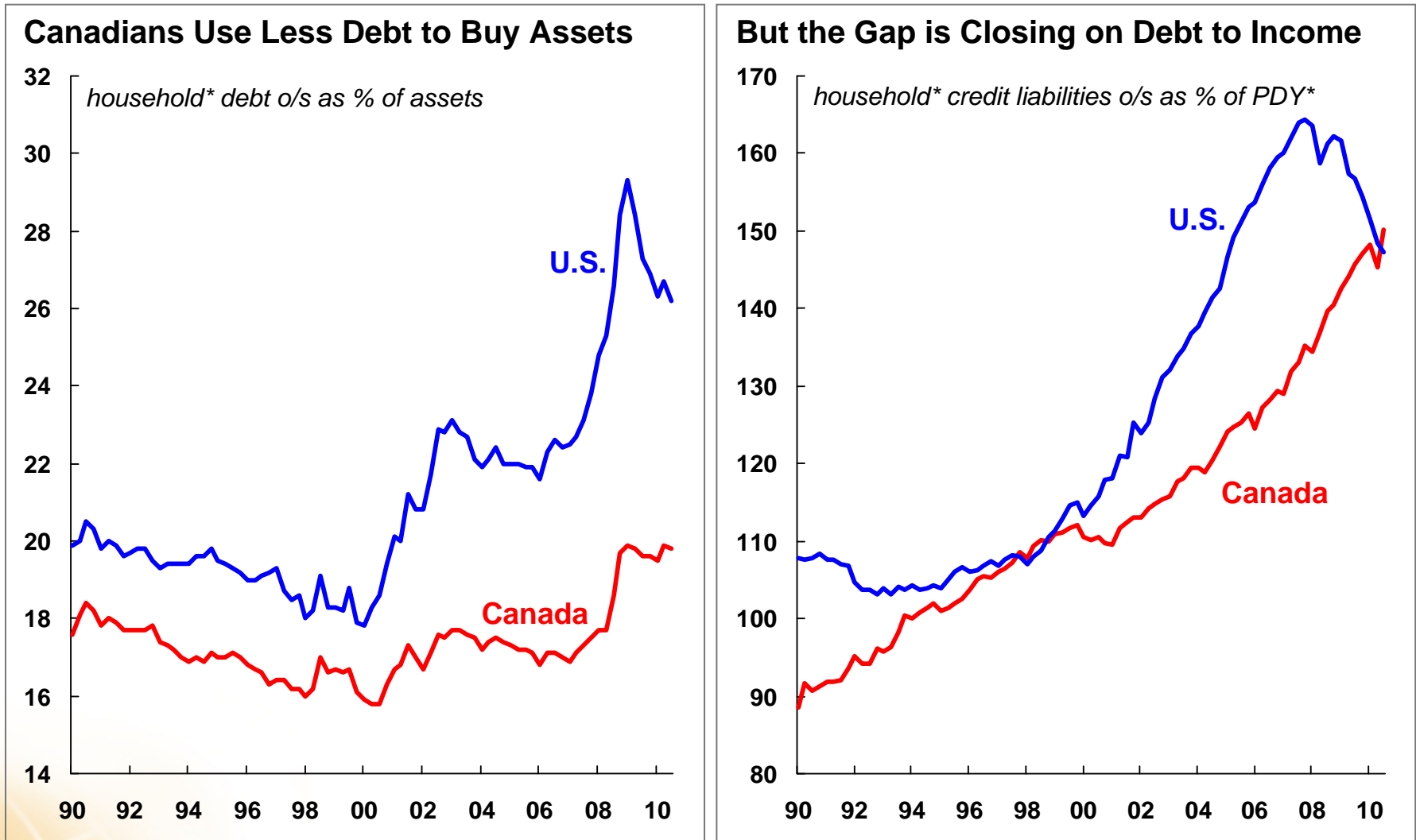


# Big-Ticket Sales Have Held Up Better Here



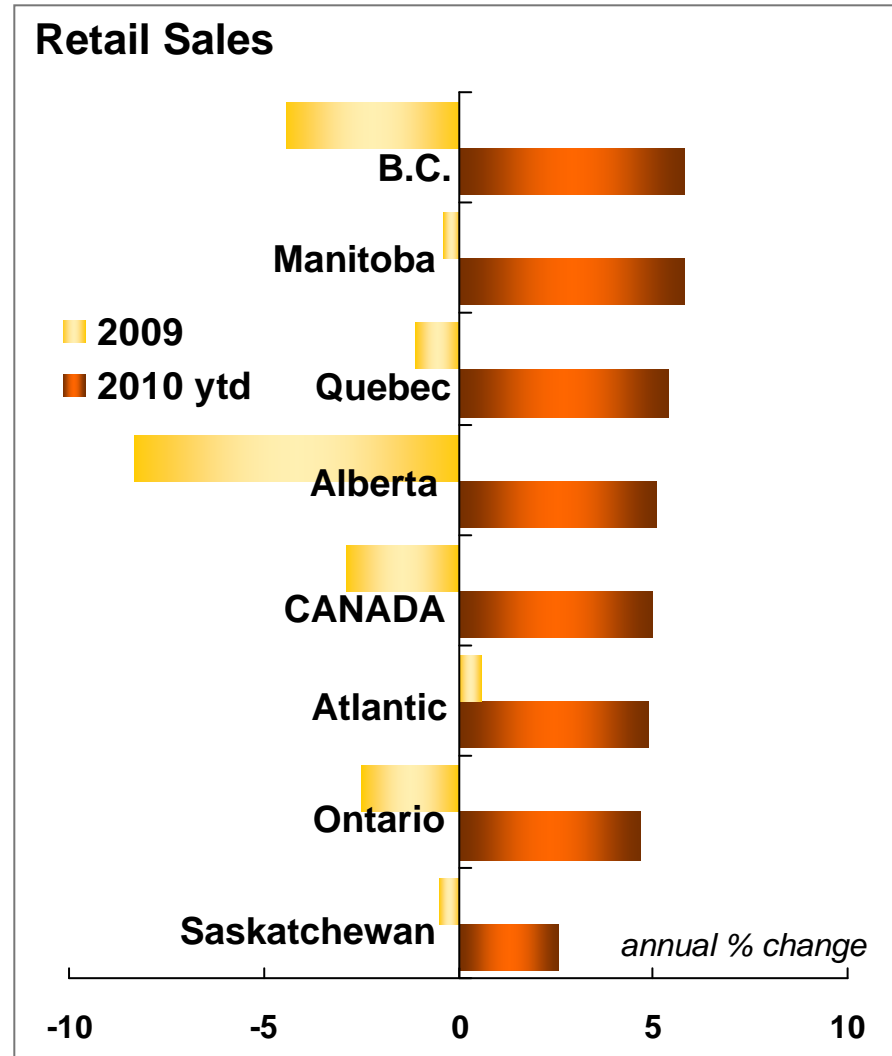
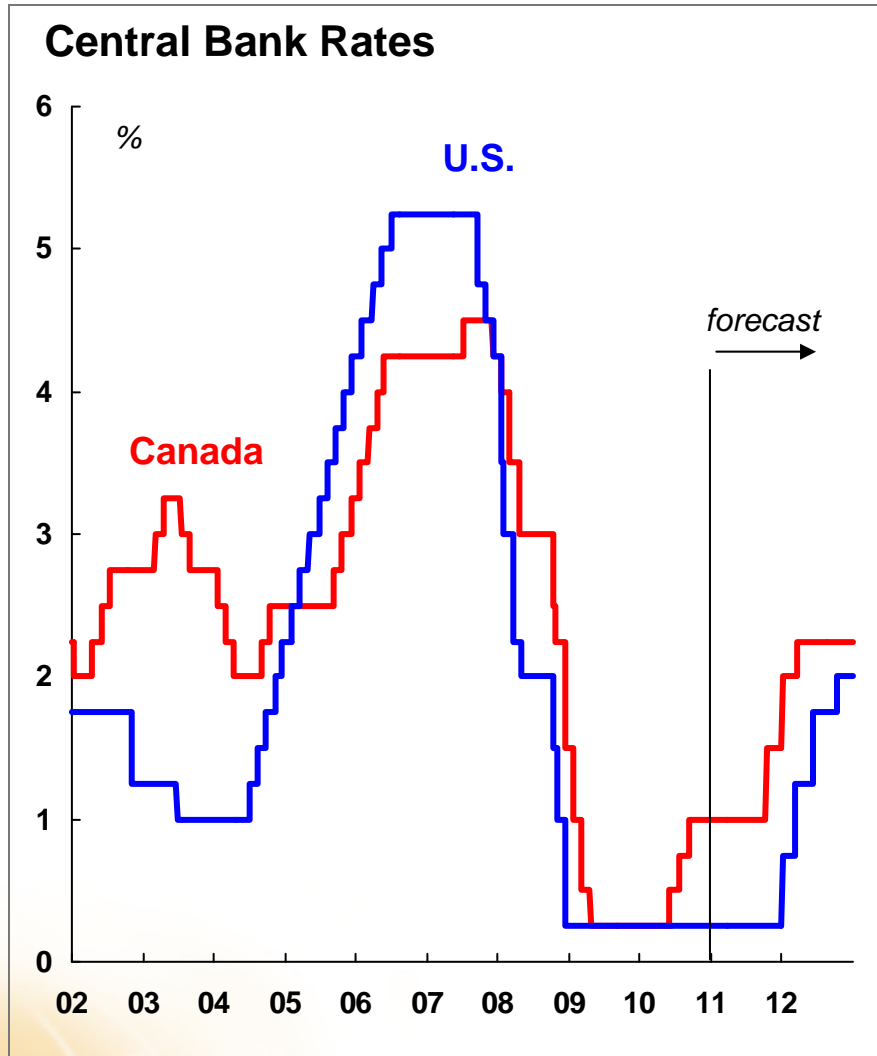

# Despite Rising Debt, Canadian Finances Are in Better Shape



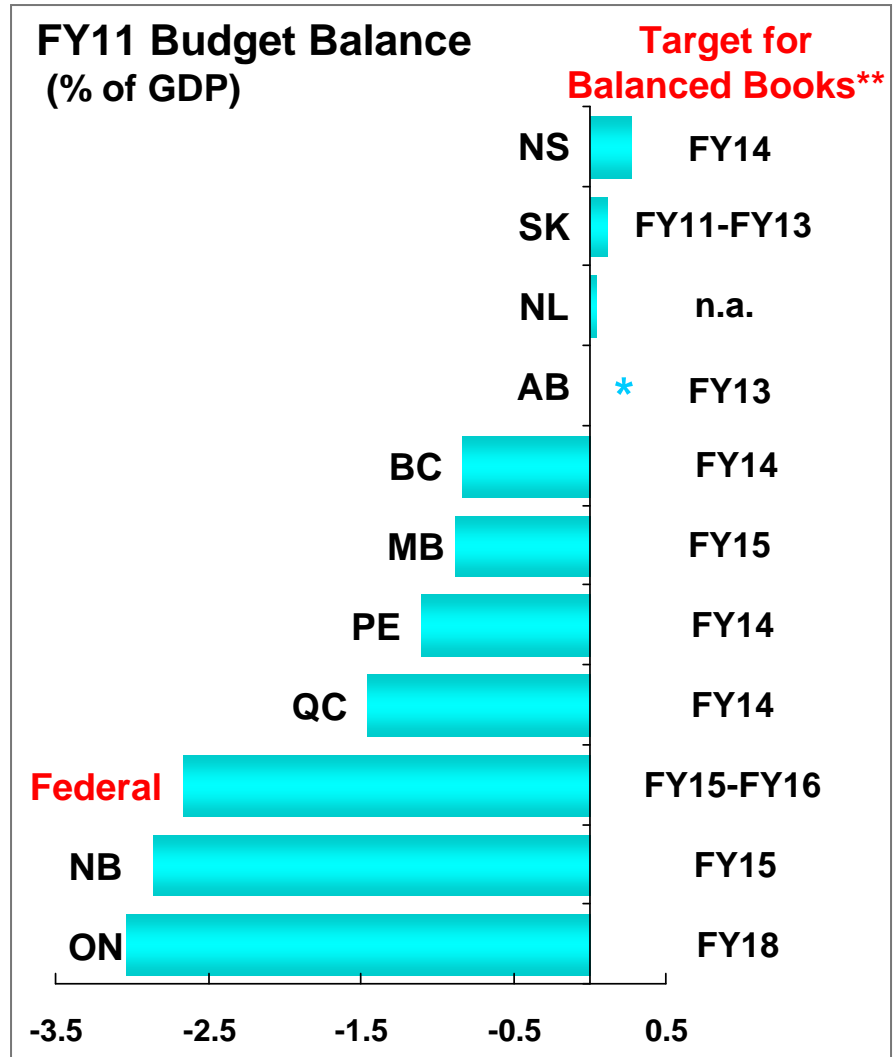
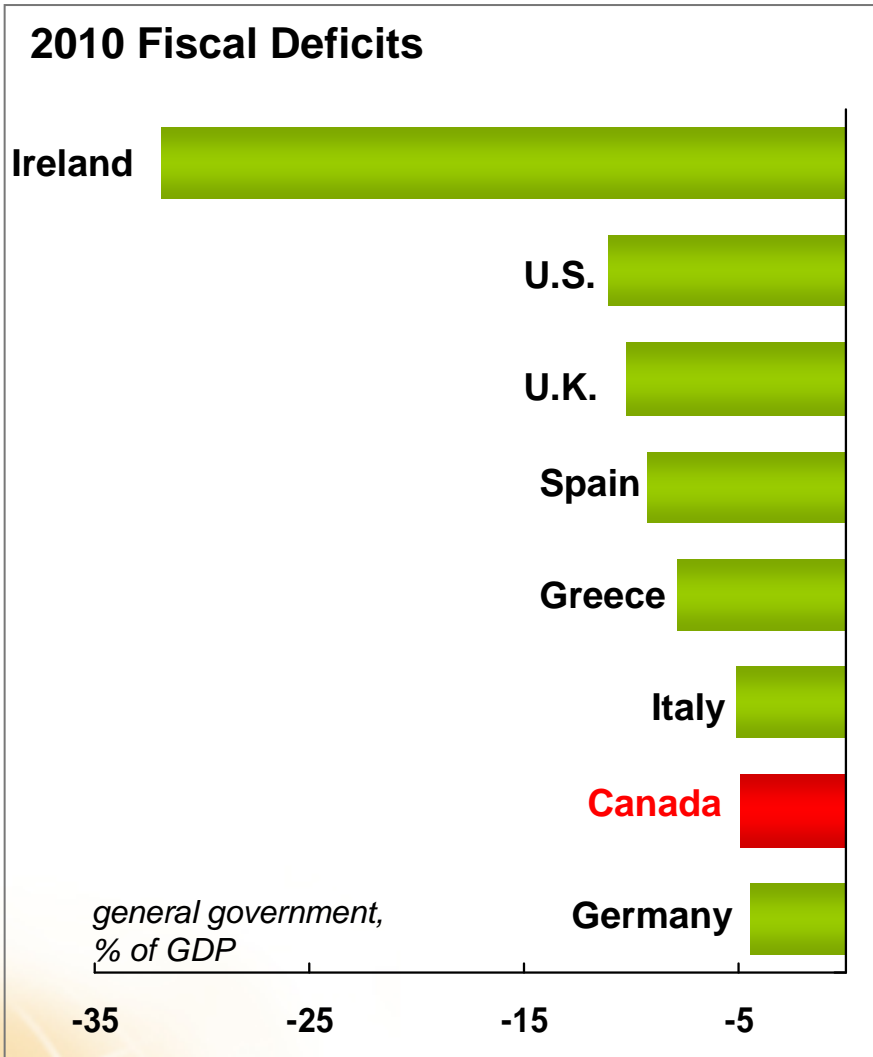

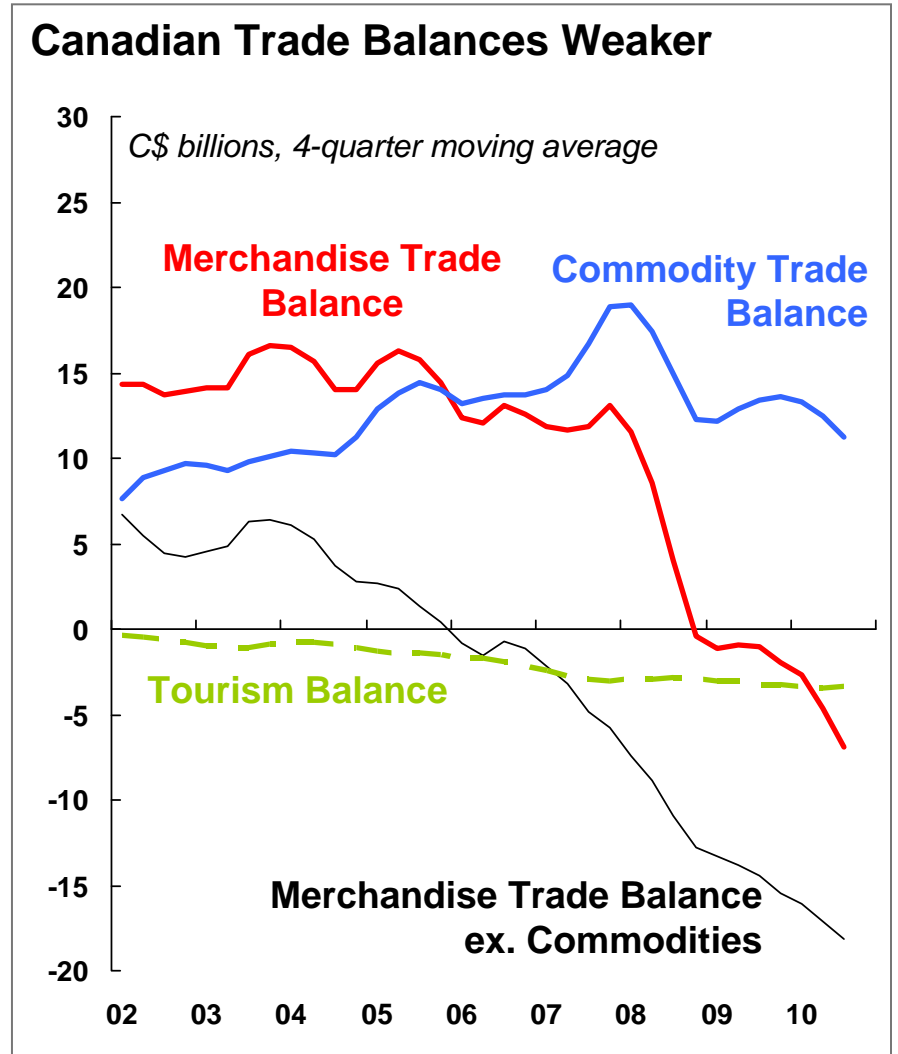
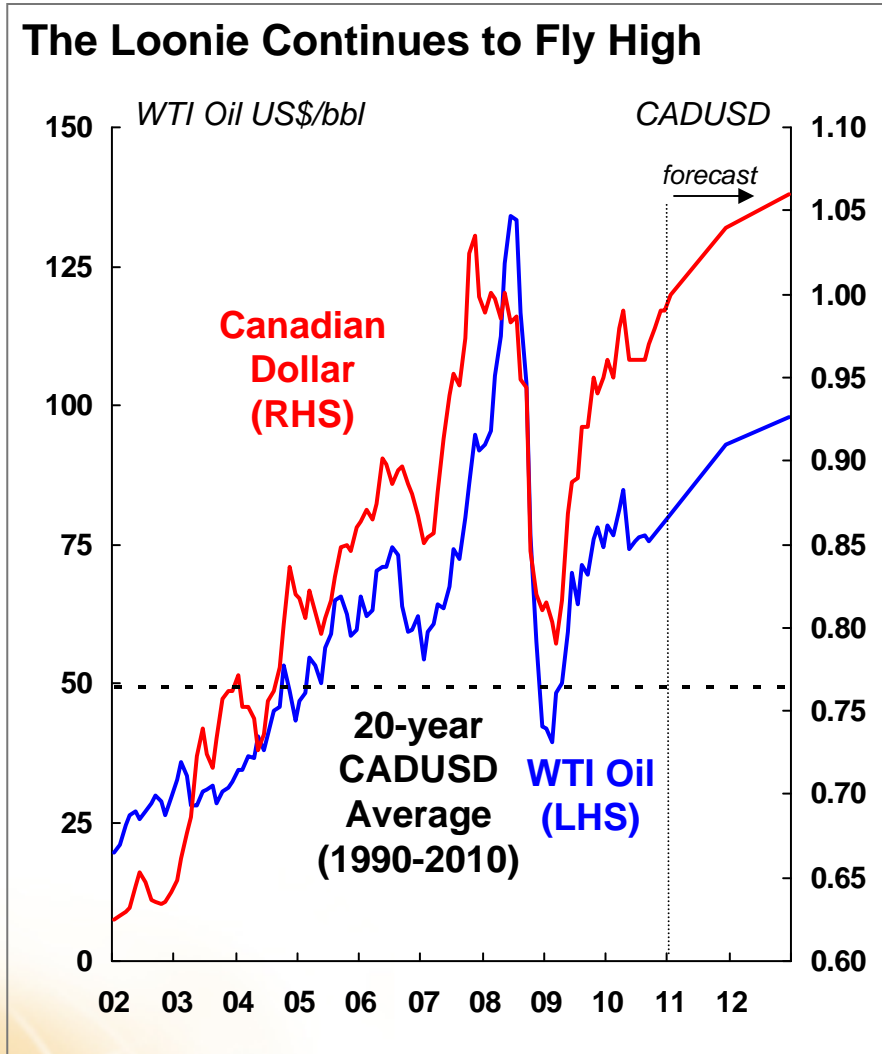
# Canada's Fiscal Situation Beats Most Developed Nations

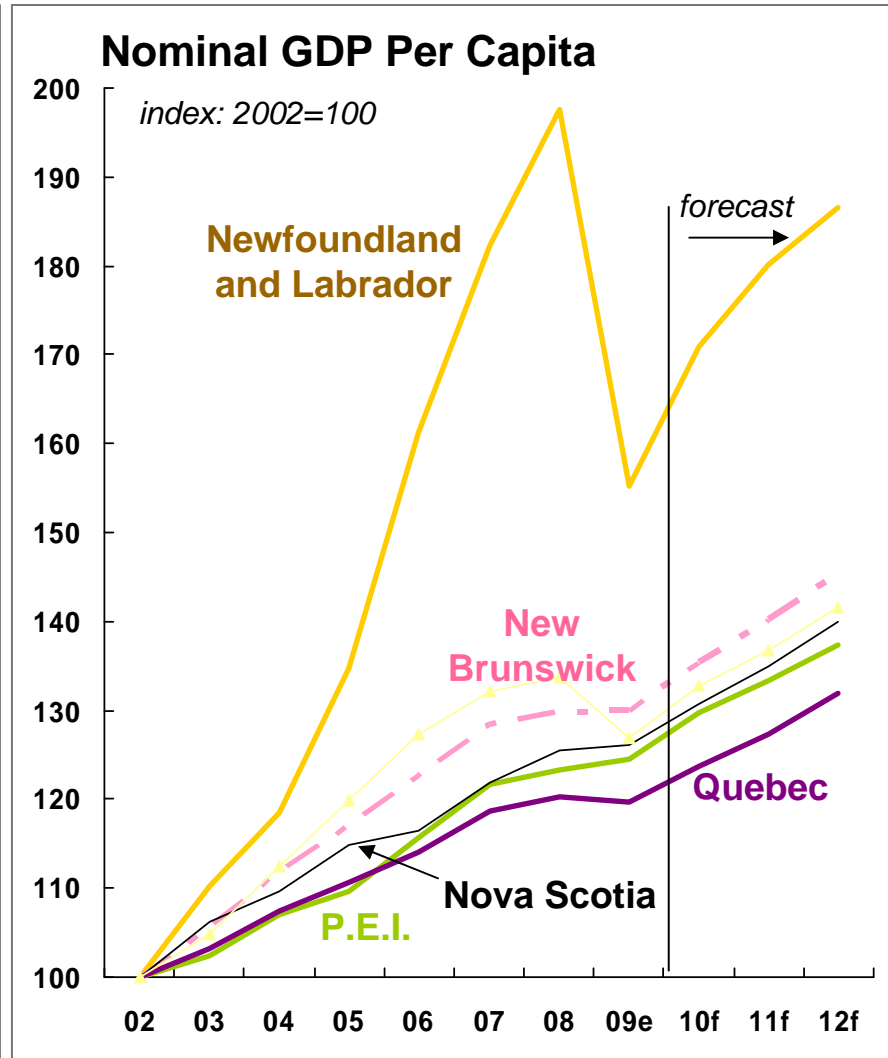
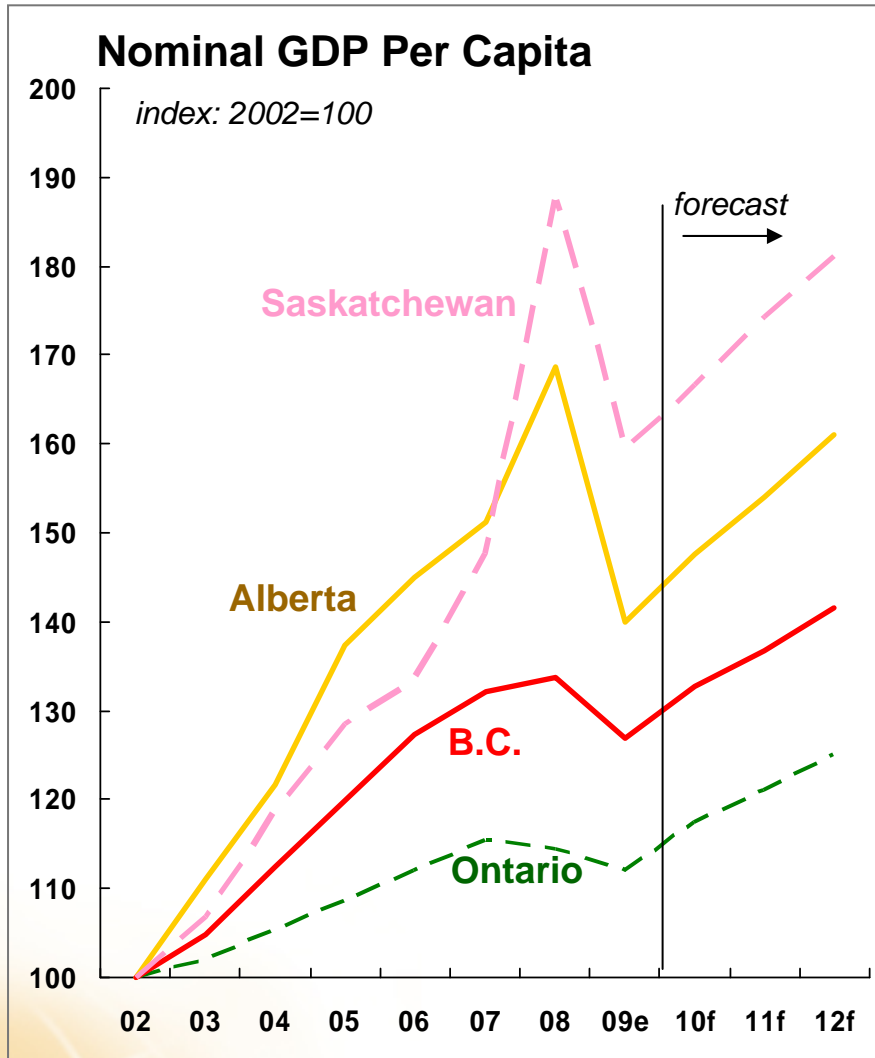
# Strong Loonie & Weak U.S. Market Hit Exports

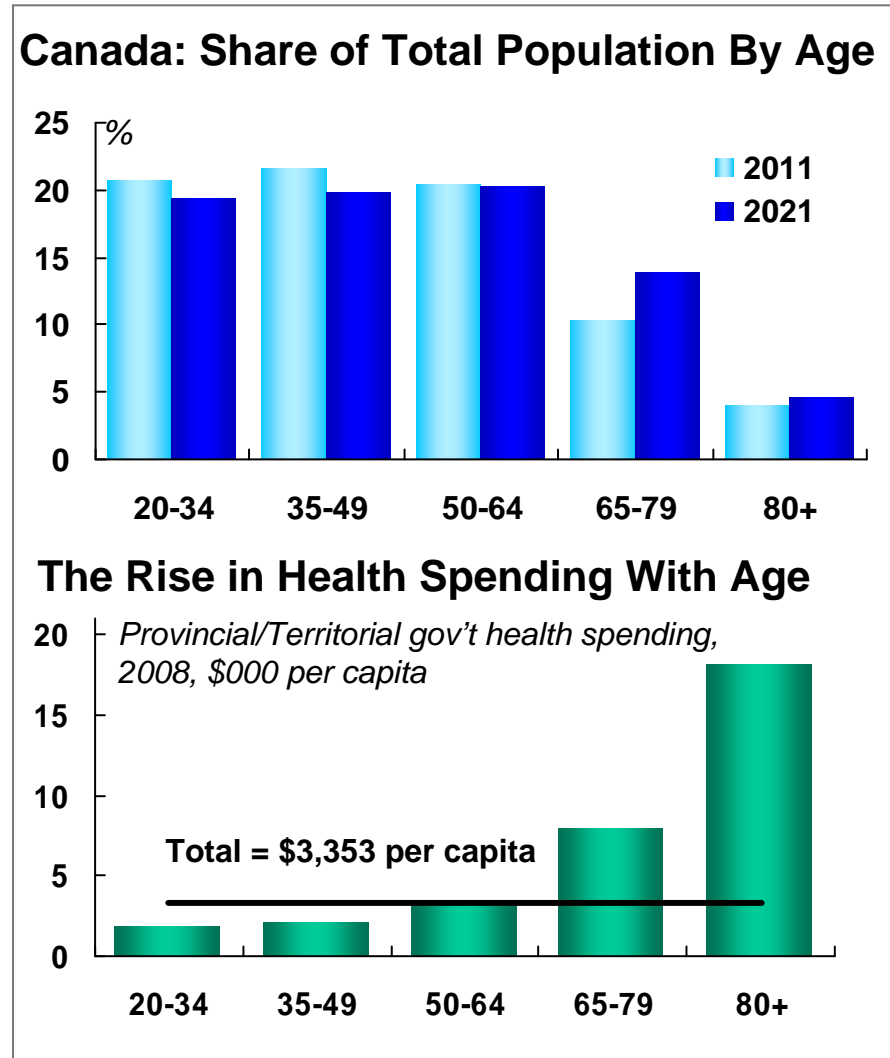
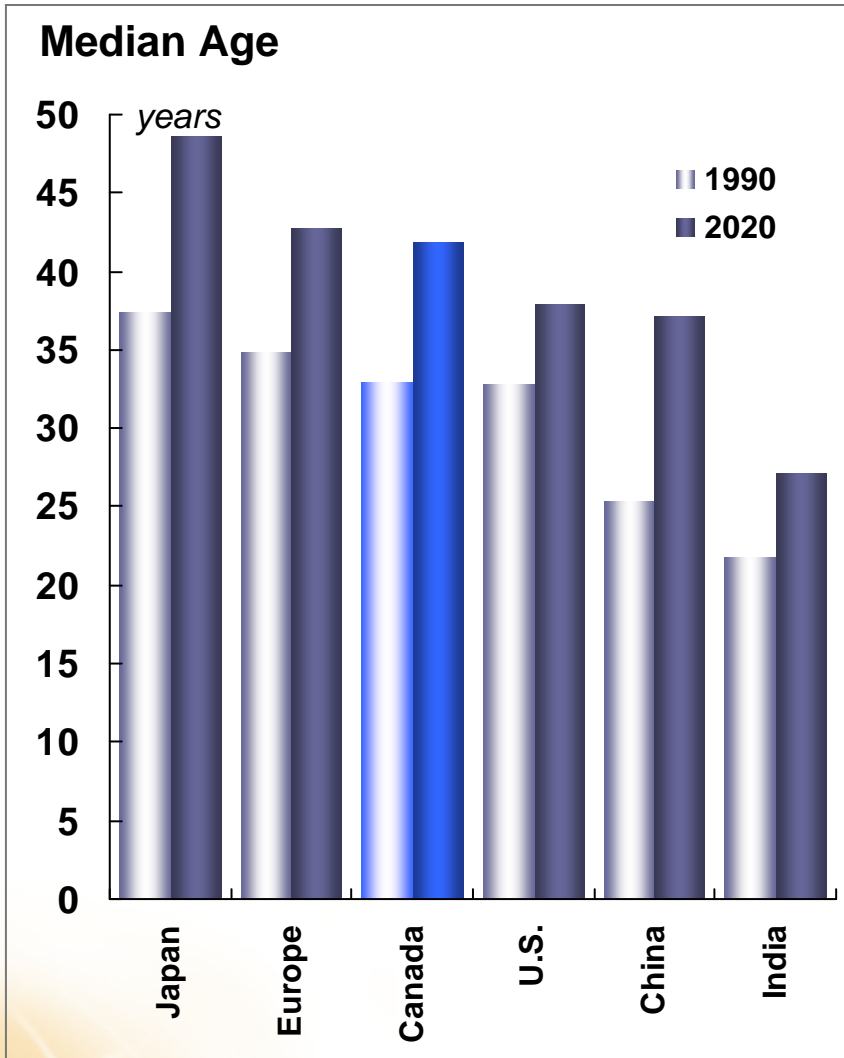
# Resource Regions Lead Prosperity Gains
